- 3. This allows you to create an assessment that will help quiz your students over information that you presented in your lessons. This gives the students a chance to gauge where they're at with the content as well as participating in friendly competition.
- 4. Text box that allows you to put any question you want, able to post pictures related to that question and you can also put videos to help with the question. You can put up to four possible answers and you can set any number of questions.
- 5. It allows me to assess my student without me giving out a test or quiz on a paper and kids won't be pressured into thinking it's graded. If a question is asked incorrectly then I can use the time to see how many people got it wrong and explain what I'm looking for in each answer. One of the big cons that I have with this is that you can only put a question that doesn't go over the text limit, which I believe is around forty words.
